You will need to bring your own tools and supplies for debris removal or construction, as most tools and supplies are not available in the Baton Rouge area. *There are some tools and supplies available—first come, first serve.*

We suggest you bring the following (if you are able):

- large shovels
- wheelbarrows
- skill saws/straight saws
- chalk lines
- squeegee brooms
- push brooms
- box fans

Each member of the work team, should bring the following:

- closed toe shoes
- protective eye-ware
- hammer and crowbar/wonderbar
- work gloves
- safety mask for face
- water bottle
- sleeping bag and pillow
- towel and toiletries
- work clothes (clothes you can get really dirty)
